- Revitalizing an existing Friends group
- New or innovative projects or technology sponsored by an existing Friends group that fosters local library support

Grant applicants must be current members of FOSCL. Priority will be given to Friends groups that have not previously received a FOSCL grant.

Applications should include all of the following information and a one-page narrative.

- Name, mailing address, and phone number of Library/Friends Group
- Name, mailing address, email address (if available), and phone number of person(s) submitting the application
- Number of members of the Local Friends Group for the previous year and years in existence
- Budget and/or expenditures of Friends group for the previous year
- Proposed Budget (explain how funds will be used in the narrative):

The one-page narrative should include the Project's goal, the Need(s) to be addressed, a Timeline, Proposed Activities, how funds will be used, and any clarifying information you feel is needed.
